## FORMAT

**Leadership Shawano County** is a nine-month (one day per month) program consisting of workshops, seminars, discussion and tours.

Each session will focus on an issue in the community and an aspect of leadership development. Practical learning is emphasized – not a full day of lectures.

Each participant also has an opportunity to become involved in a community-based project – the laboratory part of learning!

## TUITION & SCHOLARSHIPS
